



Primate Expedition Cruise Aide

Description: As a Primate Expedition Cruise Aide, you will help our Park Services Manager and Cruise Guides at the boat dock.

Responsibilities: Primate Expedition Cruise Aides will work assisting with crowd control at the boat dock, providing general cruise and Zoo information, and presenting various artifacts as well as answering questions about said artifacts during periods with a long wait.

Training: Completion of the one-day volunteer orientation program. Additional on-the-job training by department.

Reporting: The Park Services Manager will be your main contact while working. The Volunteer Coordinator will be your contact for scheduling and any other concerns.

Time Commitment: At least 4 hours per week.

Qualifications: Must be 16 years of age or older, exhibit strong attention to detail, enjoy working in a team-based environment, and have a positive attitude. Volunteer must be able to follow all supervisory and safety policies. This position may require light lifting, bending, squatting, and standing for extended periods of time. This position will work outdoors. If in school, must show proof of a 2.5 GPA or higher.

Benefits: In addition to the general volunteer benefits from the Naples Zoo, this position allows you to create your own set schedule and interact with zoo guests.
