## **Kenya & Tanzania: A Classic Safari Departing Sept 5, 2010**

### **Day 1 – September 5, 2010 – Arusha – Tanzania’s Safari Getaway**

The safari begins at Serena Mountain Village, Arusha – the safari gateway city. A transfer is included from Kilimanjaro International Airport to your hotel. Serena Mountain Village at the foot of Mount Meru, the second highest mountain in Tanzania. Meals: Lodging: Serena Mountain Village, Arusha, Tanzania.

### **Day 2 September 6, 2010 - Flamingos at Lake Manyara National Park**

The vast Serengeti beckons as you embark on a four-night safari in Tanzania and a five-night Kenya safari. Your first drive is through Lake Manyara National Park, renowned among birders for huge flocks of pink flamingos, as well as giraffes, baboons, hippos and elephants. Arrive in the Ngorongoro Conservation Area – populated by estimated 30,000 large mammals. Next two nights lodging on the Ngorongoro Crater overlooking the caldera below. Meals: Breakfast, lunch, dinner. Lodging: Ngorongoro Serena Safari Lodge, Ngorongoro Crater, Tanzania.

### **Day 3 September 7, 2010 Wildlife in the “Garden of Eden” – Ngorongoro Crater**

Ngorongoro Crater is the largest intact and unflooded caldera in the world and contains a variety of ecosystems and an astounding concentration of birds and animals. Your four-wheel drive vehicle will provide an excellent mobile viewing platform when encountering massive herds of zebras, wildebeests and gazelles. This area offers the opportunity to spot the Big Five – elephant, leopard, lion, buffalo and rhinoceros. Meals: Breakfast, lunch, dinner. Lodging: Ngorongoro Serena Safari Lodge, Ngorongoro Crater, Tanzania.

### **Day 4 September 8, 2010 Early Human History at Olduvai Gorge**

Study the development of humankind at Olduvai Gorge, where 50 years ago, archaeologists Louis and Mary Leakey discovered the fossilized remains of some of the earliest known human species, an estimated 1.8 million years old. Drive through dirt roads across the plains to your safari lodge in the Serengeti. Meals: Breakfast, lunch, dinner. Lodging: Serengeti Serena Safari Lodge, Serengeti National Park, Tanzania.

### **Day 5 September 9, 2010 The Serengeti Summons**

Find wildlife in the heart of the vast savanna of the Serengeti today of both morning and afternoon game drives. When the sunset paints the sky in the evening, enjoy the show from the luxury of your lodge in Serengeti National Park. Meals: Breakfast, lunch dinner. Lodging: Serengeti Serena Safari Lodge, Serengeti National Park, Tanzania.

### **Day 6 September 10, 2010 Tauck’s Kenya Safari Begins**

Leave Tanzania and the Serengeti as you fly to Arusha and cross the border into Kenya. Arrive in the famed capital city of Nairobi in time for lunch at a local restaurant. Tour Karen Blixen Museum at the former coffee plantation and home of Danish author (pen name Isak Dinesen) whose stories inspired the film Out of Africa. Meet some long-necked friends on a guided visit to Nairobi Giraffe Center. Meals: Breakfast, lunch, dinner Lodging: Nairobi Serena Hotel

### **Day 7 September 11, 2010 From a Coffee Plantation to an Animal Orphanage**

Depart Nairobi for private Kenya coffee plantation and guided tour by owners themselves. Continue to Fairmont Mount Kenya Safari Club, your luxurious home for the next two nights. The former retreat of actor William Holden, the Safari Club was once the playground for Winston Churchill and Bing Crosby. Following lunch, you can spend the afternoon and the Mount Kenya Animal Orphanage on the grounds of the club. Meals: Breakfast, lunch, dinner Lodging: Fairmont Mount Kenya Safari Club, Nanyuki, Kenya.

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### **Day 8 September 12, 2010 Village Life and Leisure at the Safari Club**

Morning visit to a local village to discover how residents tend sheep and spin, dye and weave wool into colorful rugs and garments. Return to your resort high on the side of a mountain to relax and indulge in all sorts of pleasant diversions. (some available at additional costs) Meals: Breakfast, lunch, dinner Lodging: Fairmont Mount Kenya Safari club, Nanyuki Kenya.

### **Day 9 September 13, 2010 On to the Samburu National Reserve**

Journey overland as you drive to the desert-like landscape of the Samburu National Reserve in northern Kenya. A game drive offers the opportunity to spot some of the wild local residents in their natural habitats as you arrive at the Samburu Serena Safari Lodge for a two-night stay. After dinner, attend an enlightening talk by a resident guide. Meals: Breakfast, lunch, dinner. Lodging: Samburu Serena Safari Lodge, Samburu National Reserve, Kenya.

### **Day 10 September 14, 2010 Samburu Surprises**

Your safari continues as you embark on early morning and late afternoon game drives. Meals: Breakfast, lunch and dinner. Lodging: Samburu Serena Safari Lodge, Samburu National Reserve, Kenya.

### **Day 11 September 15, 2010 The Magical Masai Mari, a Kenyan Safari Highlight**

Fly to the Masai Mara National Reserve in southern Kenya where you will be welcomed by Maasai warriors. Become acquainted with the luxurious Fairmont Mara Safari Club, your home for the next two nights. Meals: breakfast, lunch & dinner. Lodging: Fairmont Mara Safari Club, Masai Mara Game Reserve, Kenya.

### **Day 12 September 16, 2010 Up, Up and Away over the Masai Mara**

You will arise before dawn to board a hot air balloon and float over the awakening plains below as the sun rises. When you land, a special champagne breakfast will be awaiting for you right there in the bush! Once back on the ground, look for lions, impalas, cheetahs and giraffes and other animals you've come to love during your final game drive. Then join us for a perfect ending to your unforgettable safari – a farewell dinner at your tented camp. Meals: Breakfast, lunch & dinner. Lodging: Fairmont Mara Safari Club, Masai Mara Game Reserve, Kenya.

### **Day 13 September 17, 2010 Homeward Bound as your Kenya safari Concludes**

Fly to Nairobi where a day room has been reserved for you at the Nairobi Serena Hotel. Enjoy dinner at the hotel before heading to the airport for your flight home this evening.
